# COOK-OUT CHECKLIST: THE DOS AND DON'TS OF SAFE BBQ GRILLING

Dos



- 1. Keep your grill at least 10 feet away from your house and wooden overhangs.
- 2. Clean your grill regularly. Grease and fat build-up provide more fuel for a fire.
- 3. Check for gas leaks. Mix a solution of 1/2 liquid dish soap and 1/2 water to rub on the hoses and connections and turn the gas on with the grill lid open. Bubbles will appear if the connection is not tight or if there are holes in the hose.

- 4. Decorations like hanging baskets, pillows and umbrellas are attractive, but keep them away from your grill.
- 5. Keep a fire extinguisher close to your grilling area and KNOW HOW TO USE IT!

Don'ts



- 1. Never turn on the gas while your grill lid is closed. Gas will build up inside your grill and possibly explode when you light your grill.
- 2. Never leave a grill unattended. Organize food prep chores so they are done beforehand to allow you to focus on grilling. Fires can double in size every minute.
- 3. Overloading your grill can be a bad idea. If too much fat drips at once, a large flare-up could result endangering you and nearby objects.
- 4. Using an outdoor grill inside can be dangerous. Grills release carbon monoxide, the deadly colorless, odorless gas. The gas needs to vent in an open-air space or it can kill you, your family and your pets.
