### FREE CELL PHONE DISINFECTING: CPR PHONE REPAIR

Visitors and customers alike are welcome to come in and have their phone properly disinfected for free. "While this is a courtesy born out of necessity as COVID-19 adheres to phone surfaces, it allows us some socially-distanced face-to-face time with our neighbors," says **Bob Rathschmidt**, owner of CPR Cell Phone Repair (CPR) at Howell Plaza Shopping Center. Bob explains that it is easy to disinfect your phone yourself by following these steps:

1. Power down your phone, take your phone out of its case and place it somewhere safe.

- 2. **For the phone**...using a professional grade cleaner, lightly spray a microfiber cloth or lint-free cloth (or use a 70 percent isopropyl alcohol pad) and gently wipe your phone. **NOTE:** Be sure to avoid any openings like charging ports, buttons and speakers.
- 3. For harder-to-reach crevices, use a Q-tip to dislodge crumbs and grime.
- 4. **For the case...**if it's silicone or hard plastic, mix dish soap with water, clean lightly with a sponge or soft-bristled toothbrush and air dry. For leather, wood and cloth cases, go online for directions.
